Option 1 Activities

Walking Tour of First Mesa's Walpi Village OR Second Mesa's Sipaulovi Village
View Second Mesa Villages of Sipaulovi, Musangnuvi & Songoopavi learning the cultural landscape.
Visit to Hopi Museum at the Hopi Cultural Center.
Visit local Hopi Arts and Crafts shops with tour guest discounts.

Tour Highlights:

Scenic Landscape Views, Historic Hopi Puebloan Architecture, Hopi Pottery, Katsina Doll Carvings, Hopi Silver Jewelry and Basketry at various Arts & Crafts Galleries, Hopi Dry Farming, Village Histories and Cultural Sites with moderate outdoor walking.

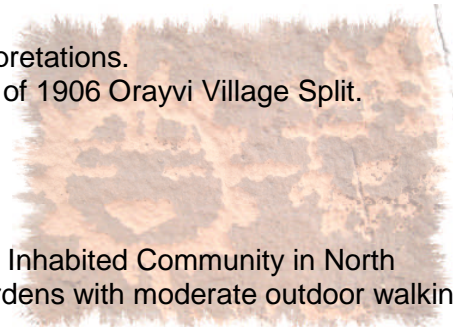


Option 2 Activities

Visit to Hopi Museum at the Hopi Cultural Center with guide interpretations.
Visit Third Mesa Villages of Orayvi, Hotvela and Paaqavi to learn of 1906 Orayvi Village Split.
Traditional Hopi Terrace Gardens at Hotvela or Paaqavi Villages
Taawa Petroglyphs Area (as time and season permits)

Tour Highlights:

Scenic Landscape Views, Museum Exhibits, Oldest Continuously Inhabited Community in North America, Village Histories, Petroglyphs (Rock Art), & irrigated gardens with moderate outdoor walking.



*Seasonal restrictions may apply to various elements of the tour and alternatives sites will be available.

**Hopi Artisan demonstrators are available for an additional cost if desired. Including Hopi traditional basketry, pottery, silversmith/jewelers, katsina doll carving and textile weaving.

***Please prepare for outdoor walking over uneven terrain and seasonal weather.

**Tour Cost: Single \$120 Two \$140 Three \$160 Four \$180.00 includes transportation & fees
Groups of 5 to 10 people: \$60 per person includes transportation & fees**
